MINISTER CHIKUNGA LEADS A 6 MILLION DONATION TO THE DISABILITY

SCHOOL IN UMLAZI KZN.

Pretoria: The Minister in Presidency responsible for Women, Youth and Persons with Disabilities, Ms Sindisiwe Chikunga, in partnership with the Sector Education and Training Authorities (SETA's), will donate 6 million worth of infrastructure to the Mason Lincoln Special School in Umlazi, KwaZulu-Natal.

The impactful donations include infrastructure support through the provision of mobile classrooms, teacher and learner tools of the trade through the provision of desktops, assistive devices, digital boards and wheelchairs; further support will include skills development opportunities for persons and learners with disabilities.

More than 400 hundred learners with disabilities will benefit from the Inter-SETA collaboration project which aims to improve the operations of the Mason Lincoln Special School; Minister Chikunga will be joined by the Health and Welfare SETA, FoodBev Manufacturing SETA, Insurance SETA, Services SETA and Mining Qualifications Authority.
