## DWYPD HOSTS THE NATIONAL DISABILITY RIGHTS MACHINERY PLENARY SESSION.

The Department for Women, Youth and Persons with Disabilities (DWYPD) will host the biannual plenary session of the National Disability Rights Machinery (NDRM) from 10–12 September 2025 at the Protea Hotel OR Tambo, Johannesburg (Hybrid).

The National Disability Rights Machinery provides a platform to coordinate the national disability rights agenda, monitor progress in implementing the White Paper on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (WPRPD), and oversee the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD).
