Minister Chikunga to Attend G20 Empowerment of Women Working Group Ministerial Meeting in Brazil

Pretoria: The Minister of Women, Youth, and Persons with Disabilities, Sindisiwe Chikunga, will represent South Africa at the G20 Women's Empowerment Working Group (EWWG) Ministerial Meeting on October 11, 2024, in Brasília, Brazil. During this time, Senzo Mchunu will serve as the Acting Minister for Women, Youth, and Persons with Disabilities in South Africa.

Minister Chikunga's participation in this important event will address key global issues such as **gender inequality**, **women's economic empowerment**, and **the inclusion of gender perspectives in climate action**. The meeting will also focus on three critical themes:

- **Promoting Women's Economic Equality and Autonomy**: Addressing the gender-based division of labor, closing the pay gap, and ensuring equal access to leadership roles.
- Confronting Violence and Misogyny: Tackling evolving forms of gender-based violence, including digital threats, and ensuring women's safety in all sectors.
- Gender-Inclusive Climate Action: Recognizing women's crucial role in combating climate change and advocating for their increased representation in global decisionmaking.

The event will culminate with the **adoption of a Ministerial Declaration**, reaffirming the G20's commitment to advancing gender equality worldwide.

KEY ACTIVITIES:

9 and 10 October 2024 – Ministerial Bilateral Meetings

Minister Chikunga will engage in bilateral meetings with her international counterparts to strengthen partnerships and explore collaborative efforts in advancing women's rights and economic empowerment.

11 October 2024 | 09:00 to 15:00 - Ministerial Statements and Declarations

Minister Chikunga will deliver South Africa's remarks alongside representatives from Brazil and India, sharing the country's vision on gender equality within the G20 framework. She will also present a ministerial declaration to help shape the G20 Women's Empowerment Declaration and influence the policy framework for gender equality globally.

11 October 2024 | 17:20 to 17:40 – Symbolic Handover Ceremony

Minister Chikunga will receive the symbolic handover and assume the chairship of the G20 Women's Empowerment Working Group for 2025.
